Notice of Race

Fleet 54 - 2008 Friday night series

Organizing Authority: Ida Lewis Yacht Club

RULES: The sailing instructions for this series are the 2008 110 Class Sailing Instructions except as modified herein. Racing will be conducted in accordance with the RRS 2005-2008, including the US Sailing prescriptions. Boats shall conform to the 110 Class Rule.

SCHEDULE: The fleet championship series will consist of the cumulative results of two seasonal series conducted on the following Friday nights:

June 6, 13, 20 July 11, 18, 25

August 1, 8, 15, 29 Sept 5

The race committee shall attempt to run as many races in an evening dependant on weather conditions, allowing competitors the opportunity to return to Sail Newport before sunset.

ENTRY AND QUALIFICATION: Races will be conducted for 110 Class yachts. Each boat shall have a member in good standing of Fleet 54 and the International 110 Class Association in order to enter. For every six races sailed there will be one throw-out.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented to the winner of Fleet Championship series.

STARTING SYSTEM: Starts shall be a 3 minute sequence with audible sounds as prescribed in Appendix Q

WARNING SIGNALS: The warning for the first race will be 6:00pm

STARTING AREA: Vicinity of South end of Rose Island

HAILING: The race committee will attempt to notify early starters by hailing. Failure to do so will not count as grounds for seeking redress.

START / FINISH LINE: The Start / Finish line will be between the staff flying an orange flag on the committee boat and the nearby race (or government) mark.

TIME LIMIT: The time limit for each yacht will be two hours or 15 minutes before sunset. This alters RRS 35.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard (by a volunteer committee of participants) at the Ida Lewis Yacht Club at a time to be determined.

SCORING: Scoring shall be in accordance with RRS A 2. Low Point System. There will be one throw out for every six races conducted.
