

Beautiful night for sailing. With the wind at 170 to 190 Robin chose NE of Jamestown harbor to set up the start line and sent the 16 boats on the line to an orange Tet that was set up approx. .8 miles away on a 170 degree course. The leeward mark was C then to finish. The tide was flooding. The wind was 3 to 6 knots. Boat 121 was over early. It took a while for the group to get to the windward mark.

The wind shifted briefly to 205 and a course change was signaled to use S as the next turning mark, this also shortened the course. Robin set up the finish SW of Fort Adams. The wind shifted back to 170. 226 got the gun. A challenging race to say the least with the light and variable wind.
