

J/24 RACE SUMMER SERIES

JULY 27

The results of tonight's racing are attached. There were thirteen boats racing. We ran three races. The first used a course of Q(p) 6(p). The second and third used a tetrahedron (rounded to port) as the windward mark and 6(p) as the leeward mark. The first attempt to start race 1, ended in a general recall. Three boats (5208, 1948, and 3360) were identified as OCS during the second start of race 1. Boat 3360 returned and rounded the mark. Boats 5208 and 1948 did not return and were scored as OCS.

After the first race, a tetrahedron was dropped to serve as the windward mark. The mark was used to shorten the course and account for a wind shift. The second and third races started with no recalls.

At the end of the second race, J24 1948 reported a protect against 2991.

At the end of the third race, the following protests were reported:

3360 protests 2803.
5291 protests 2803,
4453 protests 2991, and
2991 protests 2803.

There was no representative from the Fleet with the Race Committee this evening.
