

# J/24 RACE SUMMER SERIES

AUGUST 3

Tonight's results are attached. There were twelve boats racing. We ran two races. Both races used mark Y as the windward mark and a dropped tetrahedron as the leeward mark. Ida was set up just south of mark 9 east of Rose Island. The windward mark was approximately one nautical mile from the starting line. The first attempt to start race one resulted in a general recall. The AP flag was raised during the second attempt to start race one to correct a problem with the starting pin. Once the pin was adjusted, the AP was lowered and the second attempt to start race one went off without incident. There were no recalls for the start of the second race.

We adjusted the course for the second race by moving the leeward mark and finish line closer to the windward mark. While we were adjusting the course, the mark boat was forced to anchor, raise an "M" flag, and serve as the leeward mark. The signal boat picked up the finish pin and setup the finish line.

The Fleet was well represented by Barbara Barry of J24 5291 (Obstreperous). She was placed on the mark boat.

There were no protests reported to the race committee this evening.
